

Extended Learning Opportunities

Ashland Elementary School will be responsible for the monitoring of student progress, grading of assignments and testing of students who participate in “distance education” coursework. Work completed through correspondence, video-based, internet-based and online courses, will be included in the student’s transcript and considered when determining appropriate grade placement for the student. Coursework completed through an approved home education program will be considered when determining the appropriate grade placement.

Students are encouraged to actively pursue outside interests by engaging in extended learning opportunities (ELO). In order for a student to include an extended learning experience in the student’s e-learning portfolio, the student must receive prior approval from the Principal. Additionally, ~~the student~~ any ELO must align with the school’s learning progressions. If an ELO is approved by the Principal, then a certified educator will be assigned to monitor the student’s ELO and ultimately, determine if the student has demonstrated evidence of meeting the ELOs outlined learning goal(s), if the goal(s) have been achieved, the student will receive recognition of completion in the student’s e-learning portfolio.
