

**Student Conduct**

The Ashland School District believes that all student behavior must be based on respect and consideration for the rights of others.

At the opening of the school year, each student shall receive a publication listing the rules and regulations to which they are subject and any revisions and/or additions as they progress through the school year.

Students have a responsibility to know and respect the rules and regulations of the school. Students have the further responsibility to behave in a manner appropriate to good citizenship everywhere. This includes treating all students and staff with courtesy, consideration, and respect. Violation of this policy will result in disciplinary action in an age appropriate manner as outlined in policy JIC-1 (5149), Prohibited Conduct.
